We understand the unique challenges faced by creative professionals and aim to provide tailored, accessible support that meets their needs.

Scope of Services Required

We are seeking providers who can deliver comprehensive counselling and support services, including:

1. Core Services:

- a. Dedicated 24-hour helpline including in the moment support
- b. Provision of up to 12 individual counselling sessions per client
- c. Counselling, Trauma specialist counselling and psychotherapy
- d. Service delivery via multiple channels: in-person, telephone, and secure online platforms

2. Supplementary Support Services (optional access):

- a. One session per client in legal, financial, or career coaching.
- b. These supplementary services should complement the core counselling offering

Contract Terms

- Initial contract term of 24 months, with option to extend for up to 12 additional months
- Electronic submission, invoicing, and payments required
- Quarterly invoicing in arrears to align with our funding model
- No guaranteed volume of services is provided under this notice

Service Requirements

Successful providers will be expected to:

 Deliver high-quality, best practice counselling, trauma specialist and psychotherapy services by appropriately qualified staff

- Maintain comprehensive client records
- Share data with Minding Creative Minds regarding service usage while ensuring client confidentiality.
- Implement feedback mechanisms to MCM.
- Comply fully with GDPR and Data Protection Acts (Ireland)
- Adhere to the Minding Creative Minds User Service Agreement

- Qualifications and experience of counselling staff
- Demonstrated capacity to deliver trauma-informed services
- Secure digital infrastructure for remote service provision
- Data handling, feedback and safeguarding procedures
- Cost-effectiveness and value for money
